

**FFY 2022 SSOSPC Initiative Funding Opportunities  
Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q: Our fiscal agent is a Department of Job and Family Services. Are they able to accept grant money?**

**A:** Yes, JFS is an acceptable fiscal agent.

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**Q: We have a Strategic Prevention Framework grant. Are we still able to apply for this grant?**

**A:** Yes. You are able to apply for this funding opportunity. It is up to each applying organization to determine their capacity to participate in multiple funding opportunities.

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**Q: Must the applicant have the assurances document signed and submit it with the application, or only upon notice of award?**

**A:** The Conditions of Award and Assurances document must be signed and submitted with your application.

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**Q: Must the applicant have a board resolution in place to apply for funding? This is not our board's usual practice; a resolution is normally only passed if funding is awarded.**

**A:** No, the applicant does not have to have a board resolution in play before applying for funding.

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**Q: The budget expenditure form that is shown in the PowerPoint is not included in the packets.**

**A:** The budget expenditure form has now been added as a download on the website.

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**Q: For the signed letters of commitment, is this something that I need to create?**

**A:** A template for letters of commitment were not provided with the RFPs. Each applicant will need to create their own and submit them with their applications.

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**Q: On page 11, 4a requests a signed copy of the document of page 9. I am not seeing anywhere to sign on this page, do we just sign at the bottom? Is there another page that needs to be signed?**

**A:** The reference to page 9 in the RFP is an error. The Conditions of Award and Assurances is on pages 11-12 in the RFP and there is a place for signatures.

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
